**Subject:** Respect in Sport Recertification Reminder

In preparation for what promises to be a tremendous Outdoor Season 2022, as a result of the <u>significantly reduced government restrictions</u>, Ontario Soccer is focused on supporting its member organizations in ensuring that all participants have a safe and positive experience on and off the pitch.

## Respect in Sport Re-Certification Reminder

Since 2016, the **Respect in Sport (RiS) Activity Leader Program** has been an integral part of creating a safe and respectful sport environment for soccer in Ontario. This continues to be a pivotal focus for Ontario Soccer in direct alignment with our "<u>Everyone is Welcome</u>" campaign.

The RiS Activity Leader Program, as Respect Group's flagship program, is **mandatory** for technical leaders (Coach and Match Officials) and is valid for a period of five (5) years. RiS Activity Leader certification is also valid and transferable across all sports. The program is regularly reviewed and updated to ensure that key knowledge and new trends are shared to make the sport experience safer and more fulfilling for all participants.

We encourage all Member Districts and Clubs to educate your membership of this mandatory requirement as approved by the Board of Directors in 2016.

The following information bulletins (<u>I2016-031 – April 4, 2016</u>, <u>I2016-032 – April, 5, 2016</u>, <u>I2016-055 – Nov. 11, 2016</u>, <u>A2017-008 – March, 23, 2017</u>, <u>A2021-009 - May 10, 2021</u>) were sent to membership alerting the soccer community of this requirement.
