Considerations for Planning for a Return to Play (RTP) to Soccer in 2021

Reference Guide for EMSA Organizations

When planning and transitioning through a 2021 season, all organizations will need to consider the following:

- 1. All clubs, academies, and leagues must complete the <u>Canada Soccer Risk Assessment Tool</u> and receive a LOW or MODERATE rating. This district will be advised by email from Ontario Soccer and only at that time will start to approve players/staff in OSCAR (SportsEngine)
- 2. Ontario Soccer Return to Play Guide as well as Bulletins, Webinars etc. (accessible on the OS webpage and EMSA Webpage
- 3. Creating and updating your Organization's RTP Guide as the OS RTP Guide is updated during the evolving pandemic.
- 4. Provincial and Local Health Unit recommendations/mandates (reference to regions on the EMSA Webpage under the Covid-19 tab or visit Find your local COVID 19 zone)
 - Consider Covid-19 Ontario Framework
 - Local measures that may be in addition to the Ontario Framework measures
- 5. EMSA policy/procedures (encouraging members to reach out **first** to your Public Health Unit and/or Municipality and then contact EMSA if there are questions or concerns and referring to the FAQ section on the web). **Please note that EMSA is currently working on a date in March to host a ZOOM call to discuss administrative processes for Outdoor 2021**
- 6. Organization's comfort and knowledge of how to proceed during the pandemic;

 - Accessing a RTP Collaborative Program for Leagues, Clubs, Match Officials (TO BE DISCUSSED by the Committee)

- 7. When scheduling soccer training and games, based on OS RTP Guidelines and Provincial/Local measures consider the **fluidity/changes** occurring of:
 - Social distancing/bubbles for players, match officials, coaches etc.
 - Isolation periods
 - Periods of Lockdown
 - Travel
 - Field scheduling/space
 - Refund Policies and Financial costs/expenditure.
 - Emergency Response Plan (ERP)-who, when, what, how (procedures when positive cases have been identified or situations when members are asked to isolate and monitor symptoms). Guidance should first come from your Local Health Unit. Refer to OS Guidelines for the steps required in these situations.
