- 5. EMSA REPORT Recent updates in response to the pandemic Highlighted following OS Bulletins

 Oct 16 New Covid 19 Screening
 Oct 20 Ontario Government Announcement on COVID-19 Liability
 Protection Legislation – Bill 218
 Nov 3 –Government of Ontario announcement on new Public Health Unit framework
 - Motion Passed last night at an EMSA Board meeting in regards to teams from out of district wanting to play into our district, look at how EMSA will communicate that to leagues. Hoping it may not be a huge impact but maintain the safety of our players. With every decisions being made looking at OS guidelines and HU
 - Number allowed on field, did get confirmation max of 25 people on field, (11player 1 coach + 1 ref = 25) just got clarification on that so for this weekend will allow 12 players
 - OS does have online courses continue to do courses how to make improvement and education.
 - EMSA has been in contact with HU and will continue to update FAQ, available on website another way to get updates

7. Group Discussion the impacts of the pandemic

- Comparison of how many clubs played Outdoor 2019 vs Outdoor 2020 as well as Indoor 19-20 and Indoor 20-21?

-LOSL believe may loose 1/3 of players, even younger adults were concerned to play due to COVID 19

-BMO not even 42% of what they had last year for registration from last Indoor to this Indoor. EMSA should be sending out survey to clubs to see how they have been impacted from COVID and what their plan may be for next outdoor/indoor

-Smaller clubs difficult time to participate, from experience what is the issue to keep them going?

- paper work, too much feeling overwhelmed

-fear about money

-need help to get players back

-April – May clubs were thinking it will just pass, didn't anticipate it was going to take so long

-maybe Mentorship and clubs help each other out on what needs to be done -would like to see soccer district to reach out to other sports districts to consult one another and work/form a collaborative effort

-funding – what kind of funding is out there and to advise clubs/members of this funding

-no place to play/practice, gyms closed some areas (IE Tillsonburg) had no place to practice, loosing interest from players, was suppose to have 13 teams for Outdoor 2019, worry loosing more and more players.

-Insurance for gyms is an problem due to commercial liability COVID issues are not covered, schools aren't willing to take chance that club is cleaning well enough before and after they practice, as well as staffing issues etc.

Action Item: player registration # and club participation #s Outdoor 2019 = 73 clubs = 15745 players Outdoor 2020 - 16 Clubs = 3405 players

Indoor 19-20 = 40 clubs = 4788 Players Indoor 20 -21 = 11 clubs - 2215 players (as of Nov 12, 2020) not all registered yet.
