

EMSA Covid-19 Pandemic Response Committee

Committee Description

Those directly participating in the Committee include:

- EMSA Board Representatives and EMSA Administrator
- League representatives (MMSL, LAWSL, WOSL, EMDSL, LOSL)
- Select Club representatives from rural/urban areas and across health units.
- OPDL Club representatives
- EMSRA-Match official representative
- BMO facility representative

Those who aren't directly participating; however, may be contacted for consultation are:

- Other EMSA Board Executive and staff
- Other EMSA Members not directly participating in the Committee
- Each of the four health units within our District and/or health units of outside organizations that participate in our District Leagues (Lambton Public Health, Southwestern Public Health, Chatham-Kent Public Health, Elgin-Middlesex Health Unit)
- Ontario Soccer
- Canada Soccer

Goals:

- 1. To promote the safety, health of well-being of EMSA members during the pandemic.
- 2. To provide information to EMSA members as it pertains to ongoing changes related to the pandemic.
- 3. To ensure that all EMSA members continue to have the "tools" required to adhere to Canada Soccer and Ontario Soccer RTP guidelines/regulations *and* local Public Health Regulations.
- 4. To discuss the pandemic impact on the game of soccer both provincially and foremost locally.
- 5. When identifying the impact of the pandemic on soccer, this committee could develop processes/strategies to overcome barriers to the local development of the sport.

What this Committee will <u>NOT</u> do:

- Replace recommendations put forth by Canada Soccer, Ontario Soccer (RTP Guide) or local public Health Units. Concerns/issues pertaining to the OS RTP or Health Unit measures can be discussed with the Committee and taken to the EMSA Board for review.
- Change EMSA policies/procedures. This Committee can recommend changes in response to the pandemic; however, all recommendations will be directed to the EMSA Board for review and decision-making.
- Provide medical guidance.
- Although Discipline Panels may consult with members on the Committee, this Committee is NOT directly involved in discipline matters or complaints.

Responsibilities of the EMSA Executive Representatives and Administrator:

- Facilitate Committee meetings and agendas.
- Report to the EMSA Board monthly on Committee discussions/initiatives.
- Facilitate discussions around the impact of the pandemic in the soccer community and by doing so, encourage Committee initiatives to address these impacts.
- Share information with the Committee (and other members not in attendance) of:
 - Provincial Health Regulations and/or the Health Unit(s) measures
 - Ontario Soccer RTP Guidelines and Bulletins
 - Updates on EMSA policies/procedures and it pertains to the evolving pandemic
 - \circ Other

Responsibilities of the Committee Participants:

- Attend monthly meetings on the first Thursday of every month or as needed based on the evolving changes of the pandemic.
- Consider the membership as a whole, not just the organization or area you represent.
- Respect all participants' opinions without judgement or criticism.
- Collaborate freely with Committee members on current issues/concerns and understand that some decisions are to be made at the EMSA Board level.
- Participate in Committee initiatives/projects.
