

## HEAD CLUB COACH

### Club Head Coach Tasks

- a. Review existing weekly practice planners for the House-league program. Help the coaches implement the plan for their respective age division (highlighting drills, diagrams, and coaching points)
- b. Provide coaching and support to each Competitive Team per Season;
- c. Run coaching clinics for interested coaches in the Competitive and House-league programs during the Season;
- d. Attend the House-league and Competitive Coaches Meetings to present the philosophy of house league and competitive programs and how Club Coach can assist teams and coaches throughout the season;
- e. Organize an Under 8 Development team (selection and development for tournament)
- f. Assess coaches in the Competitive Program and to provide recommendations regarding additional training and suitability to coach in the following Season;
- g. Assist in monitoring, mentoring and disciplining of coaches in the House-league program
- h. Assist in the development of an assessment tool for evaluating the effectiveness and principles required for coaches in the competitive programs and the house-league programs
- i. Attend Club executive meetings upon request given seven (7) days in advance;
- j. Advise the Club when requested, on technical matters, programs to be offered and other related matters;
- k. Run all Club related activities in accordance with the Club Operations Manual
